GORGES DE COURT

The Birse, which springs from Pierre-Pertuis and flows into the Rhine in Basel, forms important gorges upstream and downstream of Moutier. The passage through the gorges of Court, shaped by the waters of the Birse, is done through a footpath along bridges, stairs and even a man-made tunnel. The walls, dug in the Graiterie, rise sometimes steeply, sometimes less steeply from the river. A walk in the gorges of Court allows the hiker to enjoy the coolness brought by the shade of the walls.
